

JBMS Checklist for Technical Round

Author Details

- All the authors should be mentioned in the order, and the corresponding author should be indicated by an asterisk mark (*).
- If authors want to show that some co-authors have the same importance, they can use a star (*) next to their names and write "These authors contributed equally to this work" below where their affiliations are listed.
- All authors' full names with department, institution, and affiliations.
- Details of the corresponding author: full names with, department, institution, affiliations, and e-mail address

Structure of the manuscript

- The article content should be structured as Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, Acknowledgements, Conflict of interest, and References.
- Any information that may indicate an individual or institution should be excluded from the main document to ensure a blinded review process.
- Original article abstract should be structured.

Figure and tables

- All figures and tables should be numbered and cited in the text
- Figures should be of high quality and tables should be in editable format.
- Figure and table legends should be brief, and specific and appear on a separate manuscript page after the References section.
- The number of figures/tables/images should not exceed six. All additional figures and tables should be incorporated as supplementary material.

References

- All the references must be listed at the end of the manuscript and all the listed references must be cited in the text.
- The list of references must be as per the journal format.
